Peel Children's Aid is seeking Emergency Receiving Foster Parents to provide homes to children 6-12 and youth 13-18 years of age. Foster parents providing these homes are available on an on-call, 24 hour basis, for children and youth who may be facing challenges such as trauma and attachment issues.

A clinical team of social workers and child and youth workers from Peel Children's Aid provide support for foster families from diverse backgrounds, race, religion and language that reflect the diversity of the children who need care.

- A tax free per diem **\$60.18/day**
- Allowance for the foster child's expenses
- Working within your own home
- Training
- Paid relief
